## Group Guidelines

Stone Hill Winery is happy to welcome groups! In order to reduce over-crowding in our Tasting Rooms and to ensure all our guests have an enjoyable safe experience, in a family friendly atmosphere we have the following policies:

- **Group winery tasting/tour reservation requests for groups of 20 or more must be made prior to the day of arrival through our Events department.** Please contact us by calling 573-486-2221 or by e-mailing [events@stonehillwinery.com](mailto:events@stonehillwinery.com).  
\*Vintage Restaurant reservations are **highly recommended** for everyone. [vintage@stonehillwinery.com](mailto:vintage@stonehillwinery.com) or 573-486-3479.
- **Individuals, groups, or members of a group, exhibiting any unlawful behavior, anti-social behavior, or non "G" rated behavior will be asked to leave the property with no refund of any paid merchandise or tasting fees.** Unacceptable behavior includes, but is not limited to intoxication, excessive profanity, loud music, or littering. Again, intoxicated guests with outside alcohol cannot be admitted, or make purchases regardless of having reservation confirmation.
- We ask that when planning your group visit you keep in mind that Friday, Saturday, and Sunday are our busiest days and *group reservations are limited* and fill up quickly. *Busses/Limos arriving without a reservation will be turned away if capacity has already been met.*
- **Tastings are \$5 per person. We ask that groups pay for their scheduled tastings in advance and we offer a pre-selected list of 6 wines to taste.**

**\*\*\*OKTOBERFEST – Weekends during Oktoberfest tastings and tours are on a first come, first serve basis only and tasting tokens must be purchased at the outdoor ticket booth upon arrival. Tours are complimentary, but do require a tour ticket and are also available at the booth.**

- All groups must confirm an arrival time. **Any variance in your arrival time may result in a cancellation of your tour and/or tasting reservation, *without refund*.** On the day of your reservation if you suspect that you will be running behind schedule, please call the winery immediately and let them know.
- **Weekend (Saturday & Sunday) scheduled arrivals must be at least 3 hours before closing time.** Regrettably, any bus arrivals after that time will not be admitted.

    - Friday 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.
    - Saturday Nov. – Apr. 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. & May – Oct. 10:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
    - Sunday 11:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

- Limo and Bus parking is permitted in the designated Bus spaces in our upper parking area, alongside the grass lawn next to the vineyard. A member of our staff will greet your group upon arrival and as necessary will hand out your group's tasting tokens, as well as check **ALL** I.D.'s. Please have them out and ready. **\*\*During Oktoberfest, I.D's will be checked at the gate.**
- **OUTSIDE BEVERAGES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON PROPERTY. (This includes any Stone Hill Wine purchased off property.)** Any open beverage containers will need to be discarded immediately. All coolers, large bags, and picnic baskets **will be checked** by security at the time of your arrival. *These items are not allowed in the Salesroom.*
